

Effective September 20, 2021, we would like to make you aware of the policies and procedures that will be followed by the Fairfield County Municipal Court:

Municipal Court Proceedings:

- While the front doors of the Municipal Court building will be open, admittance for court hearings will ONLY be granted to litigants and attorneys who have scheduled hearings in the building. All those entering the building will be required to wear a covering over their nose and mouth; the Court will make masks available for litigants who do not have personal access to this protective equipment.
- The Court will continue to hear Tuesday and Thursday morning cite-in arraignments and will continue to stress social distancing among those in attendance. ONLY the person charged will be permitted into the building; all others WILL be turned away. Defendants who appear with young children will be told to come back alone at the next available cite-in arraignment day.
- Daily jail arraignments will continue to be conducted via video.
- Social distancing protocols will continue to be observed at all hearings, including scheduled eviction and small claims cases
- Access to other Municipal Court departments (i.e., Clerk and Probation) will be maintained under mask and social distancing protocols
